

Detached Bungalow on Corner Plot in Aldbourne

For sale with no onward chain, this three bedroom detached bungalow is positioned on a great corner plot in the picturesque village of Aldbourne.

With much potential, this bungalow offers great space inside, and has gardens on three sides. Being on a corner plot, there is a great expanse to the front of the property for the drive leading to the garage, and there is also a large garden area at the front of the bungalow.

Inside, the accommodation includes a great size lounge with feature gas fire and sliding patio door leading to the conservatory at the side of the bungalow. The kitchen is a great size and has a good size dining area which leads to the main kitchen area which is fitted with a range of cupboards and fitted dishwasher and has space for an undercounter fridge and freestanding oven. The kitchen has a door that leads into the conservatory, and one the other side leading into the side passage which has a utility area and a door into the single garage.

The bedrooms are to one end of the bungalow and there are two double bedrooms and a good size single room. The bathroom has a bath with shower over.

At the rear of the property is good size garden that runs across the back of the house and offers a patio terrace, two sheds and a greenhouse and lawn areas. The garden also continues down the side of the bungalow leading back round to the front.

This is a great home in the lovely village of Aldbourne and is perfect for someone looking to put their own stamp on a property.

Services: Mains water, drainage and electricity. Gas central heating.




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
