Blending the elegance of Victorian architecture with the comfort of modern living, Goodway House offers a truly distinguished home in one of Leamington Spa's most desirable locations.



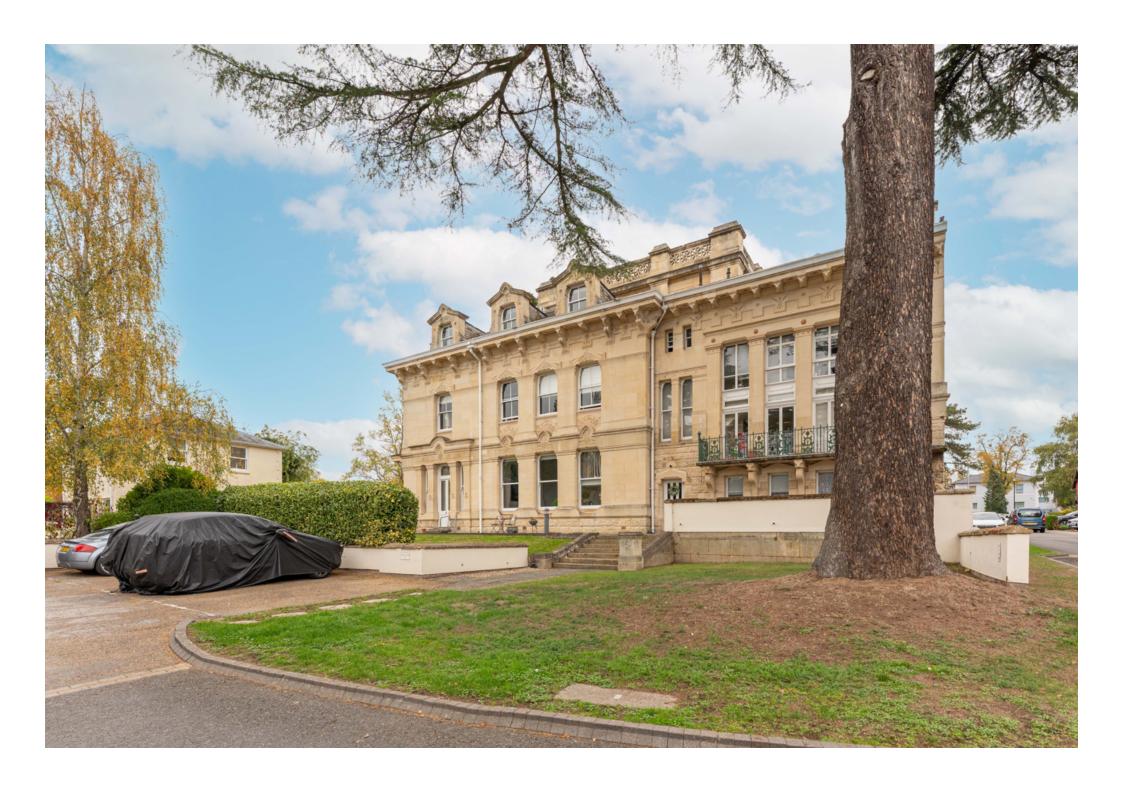


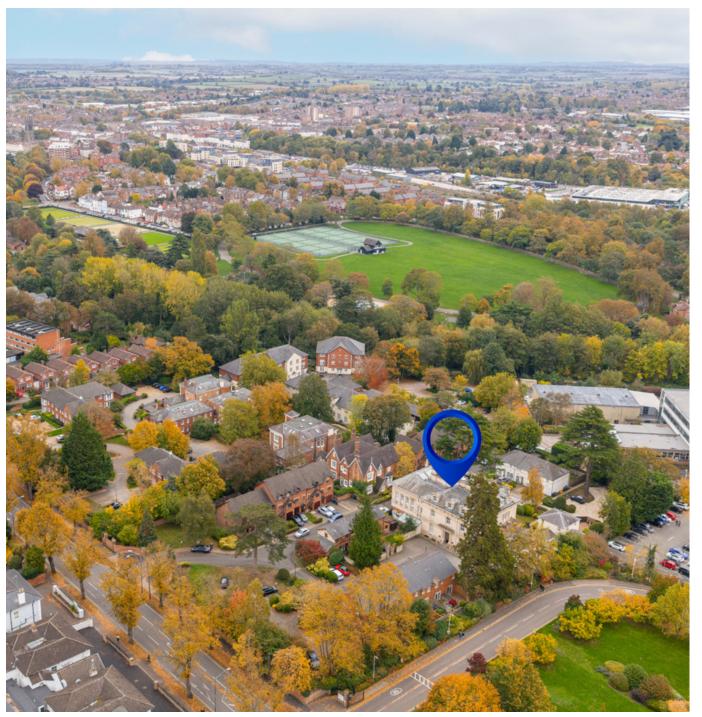










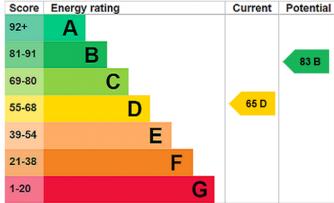


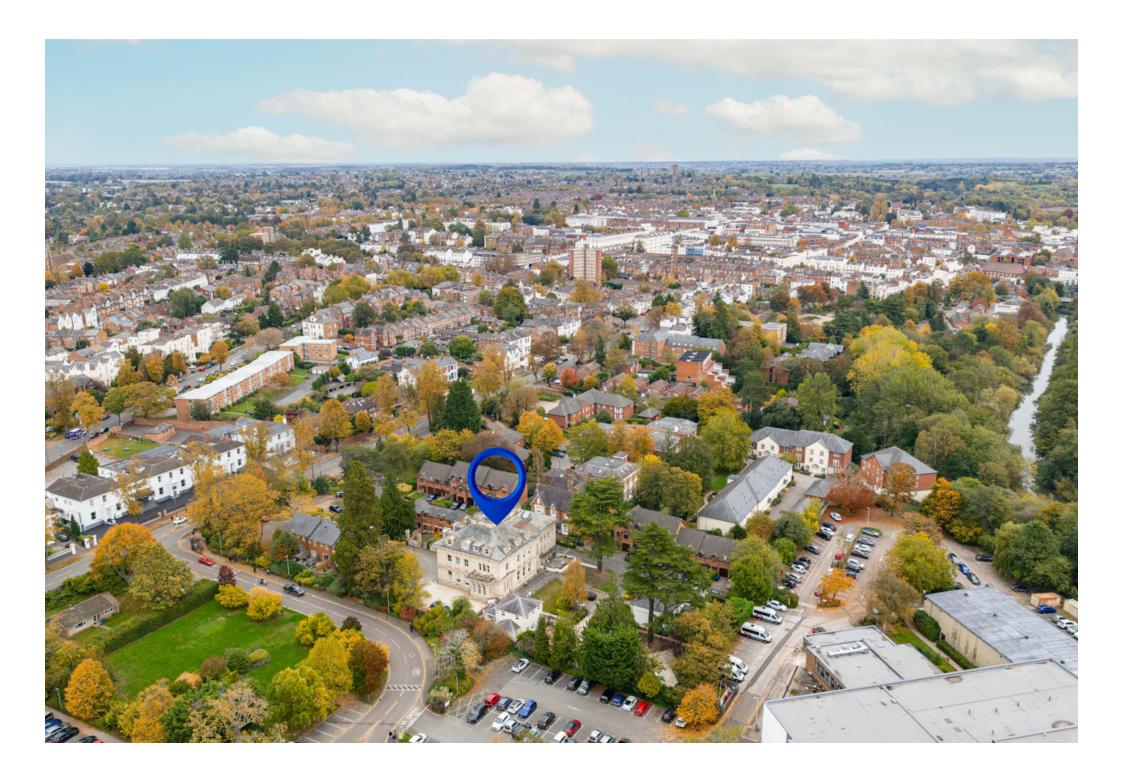
About the Area

Copps Road enjoys a peaceful and private setting just moments from the vibrant heart of Royal Leamington Spa (0.6 miles) — one of Warwickshire's most desirable towns, renowned for its elegant Regency architecture, boutique shopping, and thriving café culture. The apartment sits within a quiet cul-de-sac, offering a sense of tranquillity while remaining only a short stroll from the town's wide range of restaurants, bars, and independent stores.

Excellent transport links make this location ideal for commuters and professionals alike. Learnington Spa train station (1 mile) provides regular direct services to London Marylebone, Birmingham, and surrounding towns, while the nearby A46, M40, and M42 offer convenient road connections across the Midlands and beyond.
