DESCRIPTION

Updated by the current owner, a pretty mid-terrace house oozing charm and with many characterful features including high ceilings. On entering the property is a spacious hall with doors leading to a pretty sitting with bay window to the front and an open fireplace. The current owner has taken a wall down between the kitchen and dining room to create a fabulous family space with bi-folding doors to the rear garden and installed a wood-burner, a wonderful focal point during the winter months. A door goes through to a utility room and downstairs cloakroom with WC. From the hall, stairs rise to the first floor landing, off which are three bedrooms and a family bathroom. Outside, the house is approached by a path leading to the front door enclosed by a low brick wall. The garden lies to the rear and can be accessed either through the house or by a pedestrian gate at the bottom of the garden. Immediately adjoining the rear wall of the house is a paved terrace, ideal for outside entertaining which leads to a flat, easy maintenance lawn. Situated towards the rear of the garden is a summer house which has power and has been recently insulated.

LOCATION

The property is situated in a tucked away spot close to the town centre down a no through road. Within the town is a train station which provides a direct link to London Waterloo in approximately an hour. Petersfield provides excellent amenities including a twice weekly market, supermarkets include Waitrose, Tesco and M&S Food and there are numerous cafes and boutique shops. The town has many active clubs and societies with golf available at Petersfield and Liphook, horse and motor racing at Goodwood, Polo at Cowdray Park and sailing along the South Coast. There are many excellent schools in the area including Churcher's College, Bedales, King Edward's School in Witley, The Petersfield School (TPS) and Bohunt School in Liphook.

DIRECTIONS


